Financial Report

YTD Overall Expenses: \$3,081 (\$14,980 budgeted)

YTD Fundraisers: \$3,419 (\$2,264 Fall, \$719 AmazonSmile, \$436 PCC Scrip)

- > Spring grant cycle ended 4/15/21. Two grant requests were submitted and approved during this cycle:
 - Ocean Annie assembly for all TP students (\$250)
 - Wing Luke Museum virtual field field trip for Ms. Poole (BTMS) (approximately \$230)
- > All teacher reimbursement requests are due 6/4/21. Only 5 have been reimbursed so far.
- > Although we have not fundraised as much as we hoped, we are under budget due to cancellation of our usual in-person events (pizza and pool rentals for grade-level parties), Gifted Education Day, and paper printing costs this year.
- > CPA will assist PTA in funding the 6th Grade Moving On celebration, using (up to) \$280 remaining in budget from 5th/6th pool party.

District Update

- A total of 519 students will be served in the Highly Capable programs for the 2021-2022 school year, an increase of 34 from 2020-2021.
- Testing for 2022-2023 placement will take place the first two weekends in December 2021 (tentative), and referral forms are now available on the District website. Referral paperwork is due by November 30, 2021.
- The District is making progress on the Alternative Core Reading Adoption for 1st - 6th grades. New materials will hopefully be piloted this fall with opportunities for family feedback. The goal is full implementation in the 2022-2023 school year.
